The pattern

The pattern is available as an A4 - file.
You can find a test square of 3cm by 3cm on the pattern.

Set your printer to printer settings:
Print at 100%, Actual size or No scaling.

The pattern consists of 1 size.
So you don't have to measure anything.

Fabric & supplies required

Recommended fabric:

I recommend using all your scraps of fabric. These can be both stretchy and non-stretch fabrics.

Other supplies:

- matching thread
- hair elastics

Tutorial

This pattern is drawn without seam allowance.
Add 0,5cm seam allowance.

STEP 1: Cut out the pattern and place it on the fabric fold. Cut out around the pattern. Repeat this step so that you have cut the bow twice.



STEP 2: Place the 2 pieces right sides together and pin. Mind! Leave 2,5cm open (pink stripe) at the bottom to use as turning hole.



STEP 3: Stitch around at 0.5cm from the edge. You don't stitch the turning hole.



STEP 4: Turn the bow right sides out and iron.



STEP 5: Now you can close the turning hole. Preferably with thread in the same color as the fabric.



STEP 6: Tie the bow around an elastic.
