## The pattern

The pattern is available as an A0 - or A4 - file.
You can find the overview of the size range on the pattern as well as the test square of 3cm by 3cm.
Set your printer to/printer settings:
Print at 100%, Actual size or No scaling.

### Size chart

With this pattern you have to measure your child's hip. Measurements are in **centimeters**. Choose the size by the measurements in the chart:

	92	98	104	110	116	122	128	134	140	146	152
	51	53	55	57	59	62	64	66	69	73	77

Make sure you also measure the length of your child. Is the hip size 55cm and length 110cm? Then you can make size 104 with length 110.

## Fabric & supplies required

#### Recommended fabric:

I recommend working with work with flexible fabrics. These can be both stretchable and non-stretch fabrics such as: double gauze, linen, cotton, tricot, ...

### For a fabric width of 150cm you will need:

### Other supplies:

- matching thread
  - elastic 2.5cm
    - safety pin

## **Tutorial**

This pattern is drawn without seam allowance.

Add 1cm seam allowance everywhere.

STEP 1: Place the front pieces right sides together. Stitch and zigzag/serge the curved seam. Repeat for the back pieces.



STEP 2: Unfold the front and back pieces. Place them right sides together. Stitch and zigzag/serge the crotch and side seams.



STEP 3: Fold the strip in half for the ruffle. Stitch the side seam closed.



STEP 4: Now fold the strip in half lengthwise. Sew at 0.5cm from the bottom.



**STEP 5**: Stitch a gathering thread through the top of the strip. Wrinkle the strip into a ruffle.



**STEP 6**: Align the ruffle with the bottom of the trouser leg. Pin, stitch and zigzag/serge.



STEP 7: Repeat steps 3,4,5,6 for the other ruffle. If you want the ruffle a bit flatter, you can topstitch the seam.



STEP 8: Zigzag/serge the top of the shorts. Then fold it inwards 3 cm. Sew at 0.5cm from the bottom. Mind! Leave 3cm open to get an elastic through the tunnel



STEP 9: Thread an elastic of 2.5 cm through the tunnel. Cut it to the desired length. (Ideal is to try on the shorts first.)



**STEP 10**: Sew the ends of the elastic together. Also close the hole of the tunnel.
