### <u>The pattern</u>

The pattern is available as an A4 - file. You can find the overview of the size range on the pattern as well as the **test square** of 3cm by 3cm. Set your printer to/printer settings: **Print at 100%, Actual size or No scaling.**

### <u>Size chart</u>

The crown can be made for different ages. You just have to cut the length of the elastic to the right size and it fits every head.

First measure your child's head circumference and then cut the desired elastic length.

Mini Elastic (25 cm): head circumference 45 -47cm Midi Elastic (27cm): head circumference 48 -50cm Maxi Elastic (29cm): head circumference 51 - 53cm

### Fabric & supplies required

#### Recommended fabric:

I recommend using all your scraps of fabric. These can be both stretchy and non-stretch fabrics.


#### Other supplies:

- matching threads - elastic 1.5cm - interfacing

## <u>Tutorial</u>

This pattern is drawn **without seam allowance**. Add 1cm seam allowance everywhere.


**STEP 1:** Cut the pattern pieces from the fabric and add 1cm seam allowance.



**STEP 2:** Cut the crown 1 more time from interfacing without adding any seam allowance.



**STEP 3:** Place the 2 pattern pieces of the tunnel right sides together and pin. Close the tunnel on 1 horizontal side.



STEP 4: Unfold the tunnel, pleat over and topstitch the seam so that it stays in place.



**STEP 5:** Tuck in the seam allowance of the open horizontal side, pin and topstitch.



**STEP 6:** Cut an elastic to the desired length and slide it through the tunnel using a safety pin.





STEP 7: Sew the ends of the elastic to the tunnel.



**STEP 8**: Strengthen the crown with interfacing on 1 pattern piece if necessary.




**STEP 9:** Place the crown pattern pieces right sides together and pin.



**STEP 10:** Topstitch the crown around, starting and ending halfway up the vertical side of the crown. (As shown in the photo).

Cut the tips of the triangles and make small cuts on points that are difficult to turn.



STEP 11: Turn the crown right sides out.



**STEP 12:** Insert the ends of the tunnel between the vertical sides of the crown. At 0.5cm from the bottom. Pin and sew. Here you stitch the crown completely around, with the exception of the bottom.



**STEP 13:** Tuck the seam allowance of the bottom inward. Pin and sew.
